#### READ MORE

IRS-trained volunteers are available to prepare and file your 2024 tax return. Appointments are scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis. Call United Way at 304-366-4550 to schedule yours.

#### What to Bring:

- Social Security cards for everyone on the return
- Photo IDs (both spouses must be present for joint returns)
- 2024 income/expense documentation (W-2s, 1099s, etc.)
- Last year's tax return (if available)
- Bank information for direct deposit
- Relevant forms (e.g., WV Homestead/Senior Citizen Tax Credit, 1095-A)
- IRS letters, custody/tax documents, or daycare payment information

Note: If you think it might be needed, bring it.

#### Coffee, Cards, & Convo (Adult 55+)


Friday, February 21 | 10:00 a.m.—11:00 a.m.

And as the lives of Delia, Cissy, Amanda, and Dede converge, Delia's past uncoils into the present with a ferocity that brings all four women to terms with themselves and with one another.
