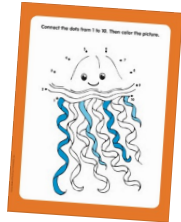
### Crafts with Creativebug:

## Adult Painting Class

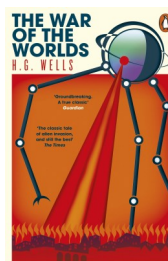
Join us on social media July 17 at 3 pm to learn how to create a whimsical painting of hope with Julie Mike.

## Friday Night Flicks

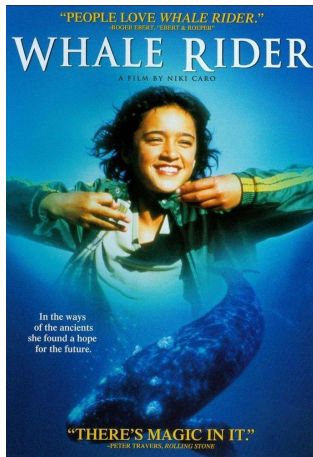
Join us for a virtual movie "get-together" from the comfort of your own home; accompanied by a live Facebook chat on the Marion County Public Library Facebook page.

MCPL's Wednesday Night Game Group is also part of the WV Nerd Herd, North Central WV's Boardgaming Community.

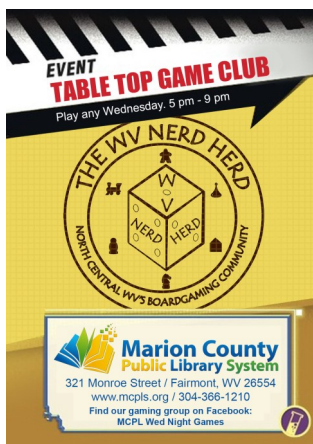
