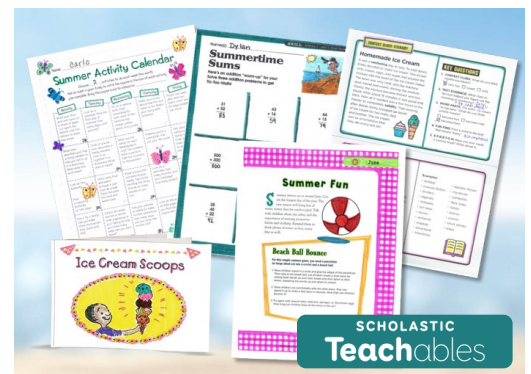
What is the summer slide? Studies show that elementary school students in particular lose a percentage of their reading and math knowledge while on summer break.

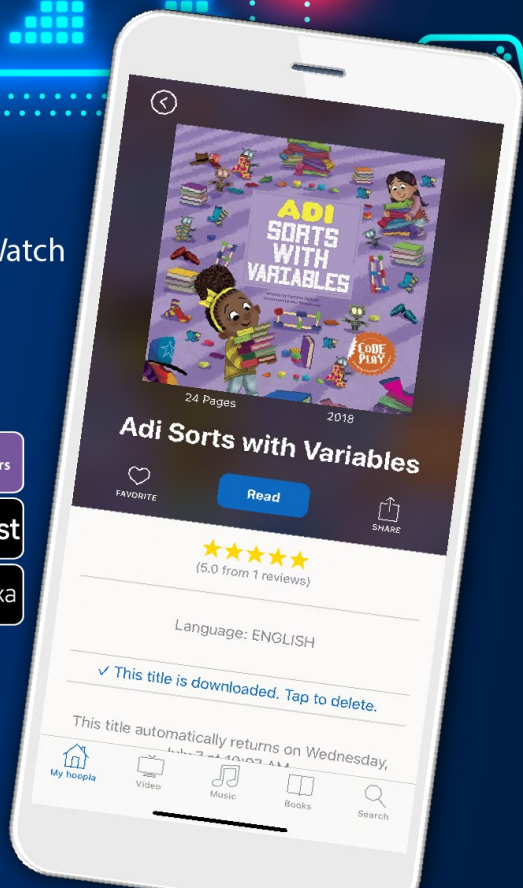

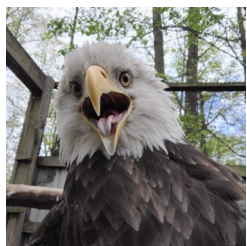

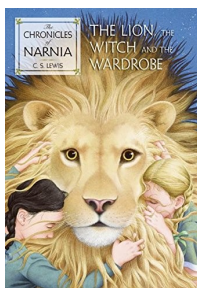
Barnyard Petting Zoo

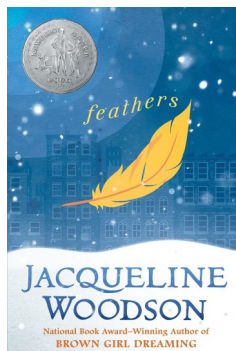

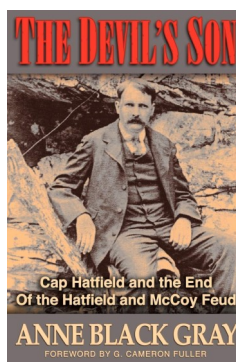

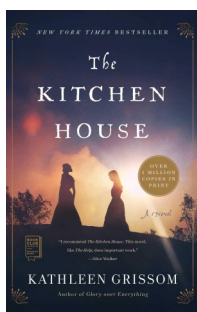
