Halloween Games General

Name: (Number of people needed), description and (number of prizes needed)

1. Jack-O-Lantern Disc drop (Halloween Plinko): (1) Plinko type board with 4 possible numbers to hit (4 prizes)
2. Frog Bog: (1-2) Like duck pond, but frogs in a cauldron/pond/bucket. 1-6 Frogs (1-6 prizes, but can do double up numbers for a prize like 1 and 2, 3 and 4, or even/odd)
3. Pumpkin Spinner: (1-2) Spinner with various numbers. Traditional table top "Wheel of Fortune" type game (up to 12 prizes, again can double/triple up numbers)
4. Monster Fishing: (2) 2 people, one behind a sheet, one with fishing pole. Hand end with clothes pin to person behind sheet who then clips on prize. (various prizes)
5. Monster Baseball: (2) (inflatable that catches softballs) Inflatable baseball catcher, toss balls into glove/net. (various prizes)
6. Spider Web Toss: (1-2) Bowls shapes as webs, toss plastic spiders into. (1 prize)
7. Ask THING: (2) (one person behind something plays 'thing'.) Kid knock on door, 'thing appears, goes and gets prize hands to kid. (Various prizes)
8. Ghost Buster: (1-2) (Velcro balls tossed at ghost) Velcro ghost, toss balls that stick to it. (1-3 prizes)
9. Lollipop Tree: (1-2) Pyramid shaped object with lollipops stuck pushed in. Some have a different color stick. Different colors equal various prizes (2-? Prizes)
10. Ghost Ball Toss: (1-2) Ghost eyes and mouth are cans to toss a plastic pall into. (1-3 prizes)
11. Pumpkin Toss Large: (1-2) pumpkin cut out, toss bean bag spiders (1-3 prizes)
12. Witch Hat Ring Toss: Different witch hat sizes, rings around (1-3 prizes)
13. Boo Baskets (square baskets, sponge ball toss) Toss ball into baskets (1-3 prizes)
